⁽²⁾ Class years generally correspond to first-year, sophomore, junior, and senior status, but may be adjusted due to leaves or advance standing. The fall Class of 2015 included 519 new first-time first-year students, 3 new transfer students, and 3 students enrolled in earlier terms. Twelve new transfer students were included in Class of 2014 (9), and Class of 2015 (3). No new students arrived for Winter or Spring 2012.

Total degree-seeking full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment equals 1936. (All degree-seeking students are considered to be full-time. FTE enrollment for all students (degree-seeking and non-degree-seeking) equals 1941.67 (including part-time FTE of 3.67)
