⁽²⁾ Class years generally correspond to first-year, sophomore, junior, and senior status, but may be adjusted due to leaves or advance standing. Seven new transfer students are included in Class of 2014 (2), Class of 2015 (4), and Class of 2016 (1). The Class of 2016 includes 528 new first-time first-year students, and 1 new transfer student.

Total degree-seeking full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment equals 2035. All degree-seeking students are considered to be full-time. FTE enrollment for all students (degree-seeking and non-degree-seeking) equals 2043 (including part-time FTE of 6).
