⁽²⁾ Class years generally correspond to first-year, sophomore, junior, and senior status, but may be adjusted due to leaves or advance standing. The fall Class of 2014 included 512 new first-time first-year students, 1 new transfer student, plus 6 students enrolled in earlier terms. Eleven new transfer students were included in Class of 2012 (1), Class of 2013 (9), and Class of 2014 (1). No new students arrived for Winter or Spring 2011.
