N.B.: The Student Flow statistics above are reported as per each student's Class as of the date of the Census on which the new status is counted. Leaves include regular leaves of absence, as well as college-required terms off due to study abroad programs. While in most cases this also will be the Class value as it was as of the date of Fall Census, this is not necessarily or always the case because between the dates of any two given Census Reports, the Class values for some students do change. Such Class changes do not affect the values reported in the "Totals" columns.
