One male student in the Class of 2019 died in September 2016. One male student in the Class of 2018 died in January 2017. 16 students have been granted a degree by the Board of Trustees since July 1, 2016.

N.B.: The Student Flow statistics above are reported as per each student's Class as of the date of the Census on which the new status is counted. For example, someone reported as a "New Leave" between Fall and Winter Census is reported under the column for that person's Class as of the date of Winter Census. Leaves include regular leaves of absence, as well as college-required terms off due to study abroad programs. While in most cases this also will be the Class value as it was as of the date of Fall Census, this is not necessarily or always the case because between the dates of any two given Census Reports, the Class values for some students do change. Such Class changes do not affect the values reported in the "Totals" columns.

* This Class of 2020 grouping includes students enrolled in earlier terms.

** Students with "Waiver of Senior Residency" status are not enrolled and in residence on campus. They may be participating in a 3-2 program, may have completed all degree requirements, or may be completing final requirements, such as comps.
