Regarding: Baccalaureate origins of doctorates

According to the most recent National Science Foundation's Survey of Earned Doctorates data from 2021, Carleton College is the leading baccalaureate source of doctoral recipients in the United States for the Carnegie Classification Baccalaureate Colleges: Arts & Sciences Focus. This is true for the periods of 2017-21 (5 years), 2012-21 (10 years), and 2007-21 (15 years), with Swarthmore College being the only institution to outrank Carleton between 2002-21 (20 years). Additionally, Carleton College holds the third position as a baccalaureate origin of earned doctorates since 1958, following Oberlin College and Swarthmore College.
