- c: Refers to a student's sex as reported to the federal government. Colleague does not store gender identity.
- **d:** Includes only those students who are U.S. citizens residing in one of the 50 states, on a U.S. military base, or in U.S. territory or possession. The remaining students are counted as N/A.
- **e:** The "four groups" ethnic categories is an interal-to-Carleton desgination.
- f: Domestic students who identify, even in part, with a non-white racial/ethnic identity.
- **g:** Students not enrolled and in residence on campus but may be participating in a 3-2 program, may have completed all degree requirements, or may be completing final requirements, such as comps.
- h: Students are not pursuing an undergraduate degree but are still reported for federal & state compliance.
