Appendix

- **a:** Students pursuing an undergraduate degree who are either currently studying full-time on Carleton's campus participating in college-approved off-campus studies programs (OCP).
- **b:** The count of "first-year" students includes all students in the first three terms of their academic progression at Carleton, "sophomore" the second three terms, "junior" the third three terms, & "senior" the remaining terms.
- **c:** Legal sex is a mandatory, single instance field in Workday, while gender identity is optional and multi-instance. As such, the percentages displayed for each individual gender identity category will not add up to 100%.
- d: Defined as neither parent or legal guardian having received a bachelor's degree.
- e: The "four groups" race/ethnicity categorization is an internal-to-Carleton desgination.
- **f:** Domestic students (i.e., U.S. citizens, permanent residents, eligible noncitizens) who identify, even in part, with a non-white racial/ethnic identity. Part of the "four groups" categorization.
- **g:** Includes only domestic students who are residing in one of the 50 states, on a U.S. military base, in a U.S. territory or possession, or living internationally. Based on primary home address in Workday.
- **h:** Students who have already graduated this academic year, are planning on walking during the upcoming spring commencement, and are designated as such for communication purposes.
- i: Students not pursuing an undergraduate degree but still reported for federal & state compliance.
- **j:** Includes only non-Carleton students on one of Carleton's GEP programs. Carleton students on a GEP program are counted as full-time, degree-seeking students.
