According to <u>Carleton College Academic Regulations and Procedures</u>, "the standard Carleton course is six credits; for purposes of transfer evaluation, six Carleton credits are comparable to three and one-third (3 1/3) semester credits or five quarter credits."

Students participating in a Carleton Global Engagement program are registered for courses totaling 32 Carleton College credits.
