According to [Carleton College Academic Regulations and Procedures](#), "the standard Carleton course is six credits; for purposes of transfer evaluation, six Carleton credits are comparable to three and one-third (3 1/3) semester credits or five quarter credits."

Students participating in a Carleton Global Engagement program are registered for courses totaling 32 Carleton College credits. Carleton College recommends the following conversion between Carleton credits and semester credits. <b>1. Passport</b> <i>New US Passport costs \$165, adult renewals are \$130.</i>	\$ 0 - \$ 165
<b>2. Visa</b> <i>Tanzania – multiple entry for U.S. citizens</i>	\$ 100
<b>3. Travel to/from program site</b> <i>Round-trip travel to Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO)</i>	\$ 1,400 - \$ 1,700
<b>4. Additional required program travel</b>	\$ 0
<b>5. Textbooks/handbooks</b>	\$ 100
<b>6. Required apparel and gear</b> <i>Binoculars. Please note that a limited number of binoculars are available for loan on site.</i>	\$ 100 - \$ 200
<b>7. Cell phone</b> <i>Students must either purchase a SIM card for their unlocked smartphone or a local phone in Tanzania. The cost of data, texting, and minutes will vary based on use and specific plan. This estimate is for purchase of a local phone with SIM card, text and calling.</i>	\$ 75 - \$ 100
<b>8. Personal expenses</b> <i>Incidental medical expenses, gifts for home stay hosts, materials for Independent Study Project.</i>	\$ 500 - \$ 700
<b>9. International Student ID Card (optional)</b> <i>available for \$25 from <a href="https://www.isic.org/">https://www.isic.org/</a>. Provides international recognition as a student, some insurance, and discounts in some countries.</i>	\$ 25
<b>10. Medical Travel Consultation</b> <i>Often covered by your personal health insurance, but check with your insurance provider for details.</i>	\$ 0 - \$ 800
<b>11. Immunizations and Anti-Malarial Medication</b> <i>Portions of these costs are often covered by your personal health insurance, but check your insurance policy for details. <b>Yellow Fever vaccination is required.</b></i>	\$ 0 - \$ 1350
<b>12. Travel insurance (optional)</b> <i>Covers airfare cancellation and lost or stolen baggage.</i>	
<b>13. Personal property insurance (optional)</b> <i>Covers some electronics, jewelry, personal items. Learn more here: <a href="https://apps.carleton.edu/curricular/ocs/travel/travelins/">https://apps.carleton.edu/curricular/ocs/travel/travelins/</a>.</i>
