According to [Carleton College Academic Regulations and Procedures](#), "the standard Carleton course is six credits; for purposes of transfer evaluation, six Carleton credits are comparable to three and one-third (3 1/3) semester credits or five quarter credits."

Students participating in a Carleton Global Engagement program are registered for courses totaling 32 Carleton College credits. Carleton College recommends the following conversion between Carleton credits and semester credits. 1. Passport <i>New US Passport costs \$165, adult renewals are \$130.</i>	\$ 0 - \$ 165
2. Visa <i>This program is under 90 days, so a Schengen visa is not required for U.S. passport holders. Students carrying passports from other countries should consult with Carleton Off-Campus Studies Office.</i>	\$ 0
3. Travel to/from program site <i>Round-trip to Europe</i>	\$ 1,200 - \$ 1,500
4. Additional required program travel	\$ 0
5. Textbooks and course materials	\$ 150
6. Required gear <i>None</i>	\$ 0
7. Cell phone <i>Students must either purchase a SIM card for their unlocked smartphone or a local phone in Europe. The cost of data, texting, and minutes will vary based on use and specific plan.</i>	\$ 130 - \$ 170
8. Personal expenses <i>Incidental medical expenses, materials for Independent Study Project</i>	\$ 1,000 - \$ 1,400
9. International Student ID Card <i>Required. Cost is covered by program fees for students on Women's and Gender Studies in Europe. Provides international recognition as a student, some insurance, and discounts in some countries.</i>	Covered by Program Fees
10. Medical Travel Consultation <i>Often covered by your personal health insurance, but check with your insurance provider for details.</i>	Not required
11. Immunizations <i>Portions of these costs are often covered by your personal health insurance, but check your insurance policy for details.</i>	
12. Travel insurance (optional) <i>Covers airfare cancellation and lost or stolen baggage.</i>	
13. Personal property insurance (optional) <i>Covers some electronics, jewelry, personal items. Learn more here: https://apps.carleton.edu/curricular/ocs/travel/travelins/.</i>
