### Residency Requirement

210 credits are required for graduation, including AP, IB, Prematriculation, etc credits.

Beginning with the class of 2026, students can transfer a combination of up to 18 pre- or post-matriculation credits. Previous classes can transfer a maximum of 36 prematriculation credits that can be applied to the undergraduate degree. These credits may not be applied to general education requirements.

Transfer students must complete a minimum of 108 credits and six terms at Carleton to be eligible for the degree.
