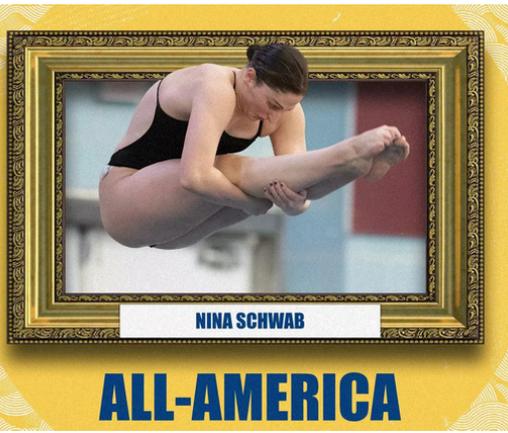
- New warm up gear
