Participation: Academic Year 2022-23

Between June 2022 and July 2023

- Carleton officially enrolled 2007 degree-seeking students
- 394 students, about 20% of the student body, participated in on-site off-campus study programs 407 times for academic credit
- 380 students earned off-campus study credit outside the United States
- Students studied off-campus on 70 different programs in 38 countries and territories

Participation in domestic and international programs highlights:

- by program sponsor: Carleton 80% (76% Carleton 10-week or break programs, 4% Global Engagement Programs); Non-Carleton 19%, Consortia 1%
- by world region: 59% Europe, 14% Asia, 13 % Australia/Pacific Islands, 10% North America, 4% Africa, <1% each: Middle East, South America, and Multi-location programs
- by number of programs: 97% of students participated in one program and 3% participated in two programs, and <1% participated in three programs
- by class year: 50% juniors, 35% sophomores, and 15% sophomores
- by program length: 71% one-term programs, 20% semester programs, 9% break and less than one term programs, and <1% academic year-long programs
- 58% of participants were women and 42% were men

As in previous years, Carleton faculty took an active role in off-campus studies as directors of off-campus programs. This report covers students who earned Carleton credit on off-campus academic programs. It does not report students who earned Carleton independent study credits for academic work completed off campus. A number of students were also involved in volunteer projects, work abroad, domestic and international field camps in geology, biology, and archeology, and independent travel. The attached statistical tables, combined with the annual “Class of 2023 Participation in Off-Campus Studies” report, provide an in-depth view of off-campus studies at Carleton College.

Participation: Class Year 2023

The 490 members of the class of 2023 provide an interesting profile of Off-Campus Studies:

- 48% of the class of 2023 participated in off-campus study programs
- 234 students participated 277 times in off-campus study programming during their four years or 12 terms
- 10 of these students participated in the winter break 2020 programs (Climate and Health: Science to Practice; and Public Policy in Practice) that had their OCS field trips cancelled due to the pandemic
- 218 students earned off-campus study credit outside the United States 252 times
- Students participated in 75 different off-campus programs in 41 countries and territories

Participation highlights:

- by program sponsor: 57% Carleton term, winter break, and spring break programs, 41% non-Carleton programs (40% non-Carleton, 1% Consortia), and 2% Carleton Global Engagement Programs
- by world region: Europe 69%, North America 10%, Africa 4%, Asia 4%, Middle East 4%, Australia/Pacific Islands 4%, South America 1%, Multi-location <1%.
- by number of programs: 83% one program, 16% two programs, 1% three programs
- by class standing at time of participation: 54% juniors, 23% sophomores, 23% seniors
- by program length: 62% one term, 22% one semester, 15% less than one term (summer programs, winter or spring break programs), and 1% academic year-long programs
- 61% of the participants were women and 39% were men

This report covers students who earned Carleton credit on off-campus study programs. Not included are credit and non-credit internships, fellowships, geology, biology, and archaeology field camps, and volunteer experiences that provided additional off-campus study opportunities for the members of the class of 2023.
