
Knights Sports Highlights

Carleton's Eclipse made it to the championship game of the Women's D-III National Championships in Ultimate before coming up just short against Middlebury. Carleton's men's and women's D-I teams, <u>CUT</u> and <u>Syzygy</u>, will kick off their championship tournament this Friday. Stay up to date on results!




Sarah Zheng '26 were
