

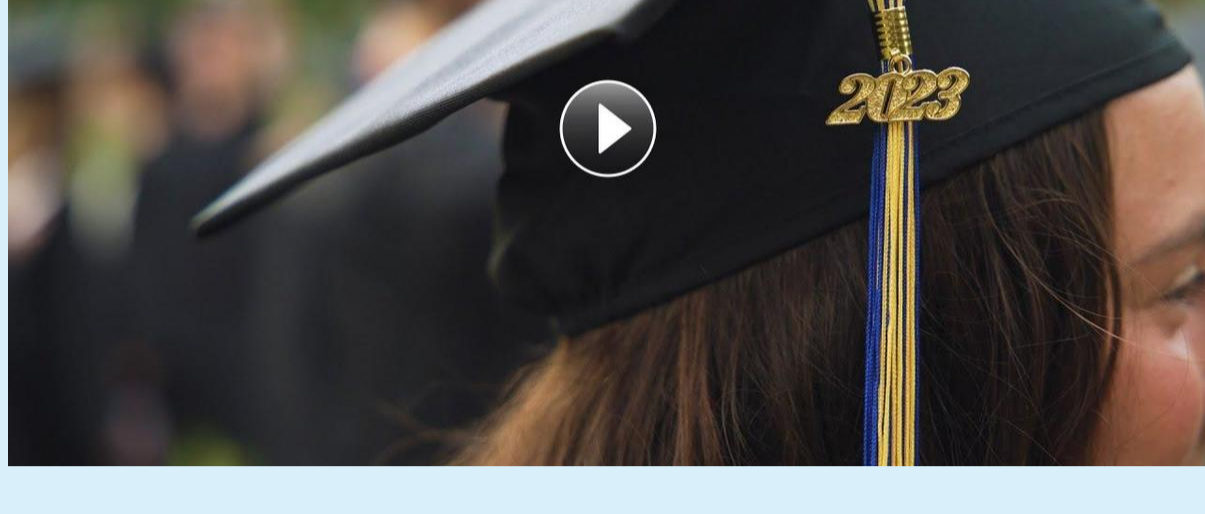

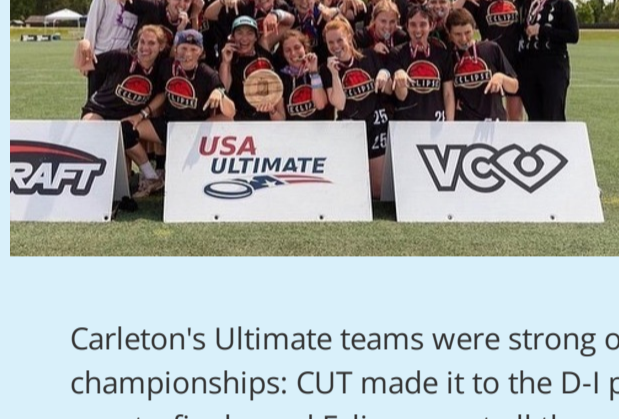

Carleton's Ultimate teams were strong once again in the national Ultimate championships: CUT made it to the D-I pre-quarterfinals, Syzygy to the D-I quarterfinals, and Eclipse went all the way to the top and ended their D-III run as second in the nation.

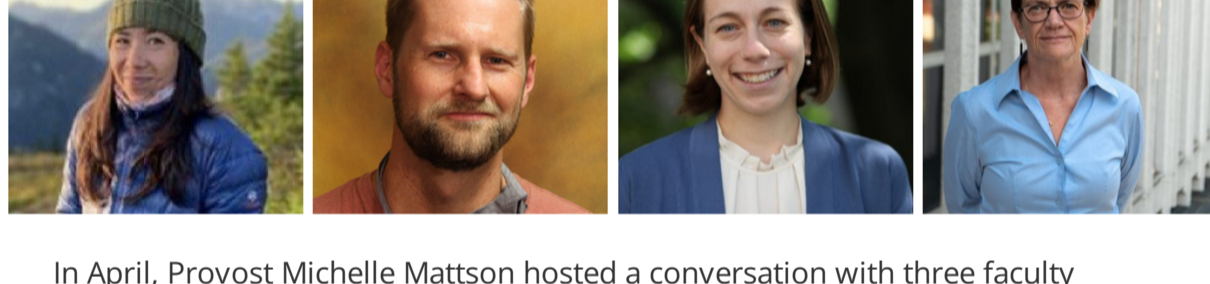
In NCAA competition, several of our women's teams stood out this spring. The women's tennis team ended their extremely successful undefeated season with a [loss to the No. 1 ranked University of Chicago](#) in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Championships in May. In track and field, [Clara Mayfield '23 finished fourth in the 5,000-meter run](#) and third in the 10,000-meter run, while [Mary Blanchard '24 broke her own school record, placing 10th in the 800-meter run](#). The [women's golf team ended the season placing 15th in the NCAA Championships](#), with [Carter Sichol '26](#) finishing 10th overall and being named MIAC Rookie of the Year.
