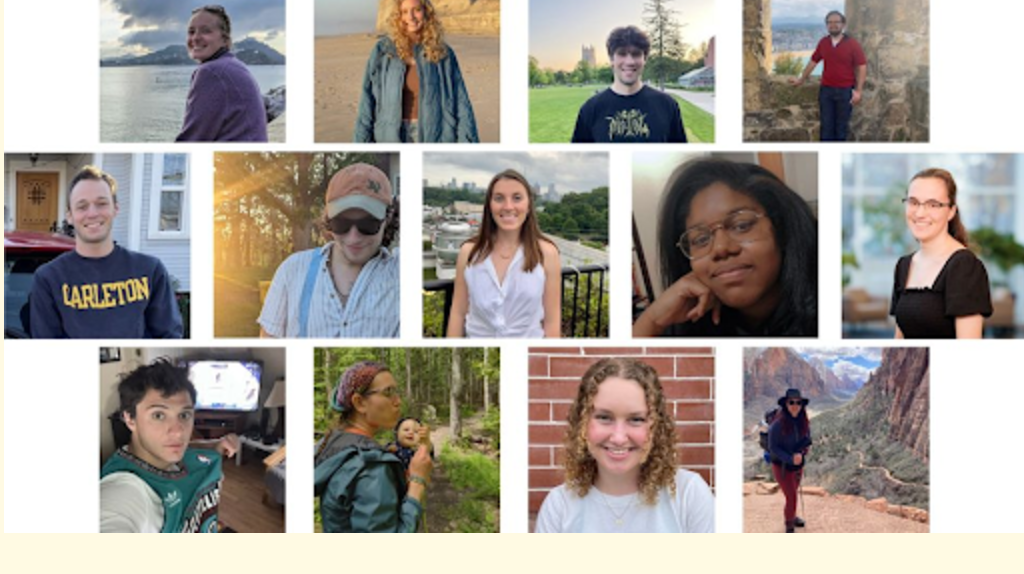
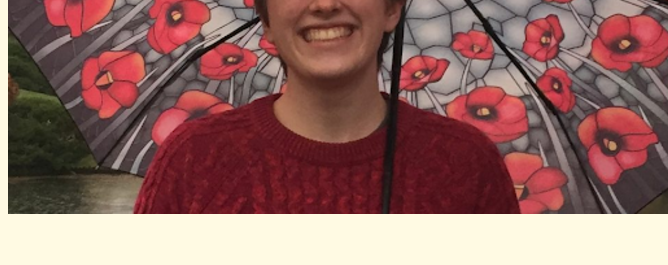

### Carls Recognized With Scholarships and Awards

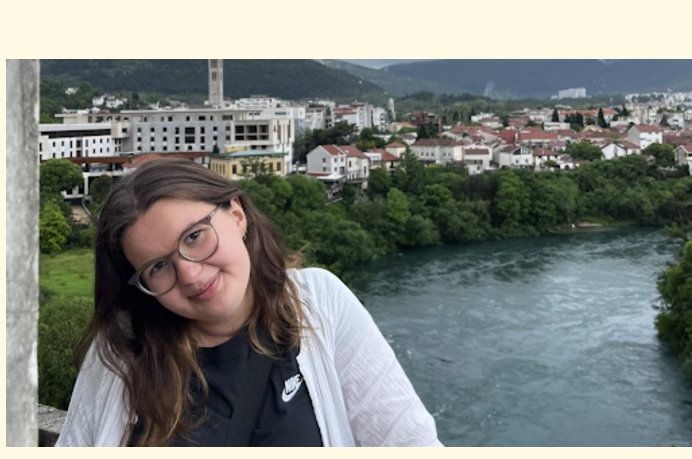
Mathematics major [Annemily Hoganson '24](#) joined just 412 other American undergraduate sophomores and juniors this year in receiving the [Goldwater Scholarship](#) for outstanding academic achievements in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM).

[Mia Strubal Iram '25](#) was awarded the [Newman Civic Fellowship](#), in recognition of her work in dialogue facilitation and social justice.

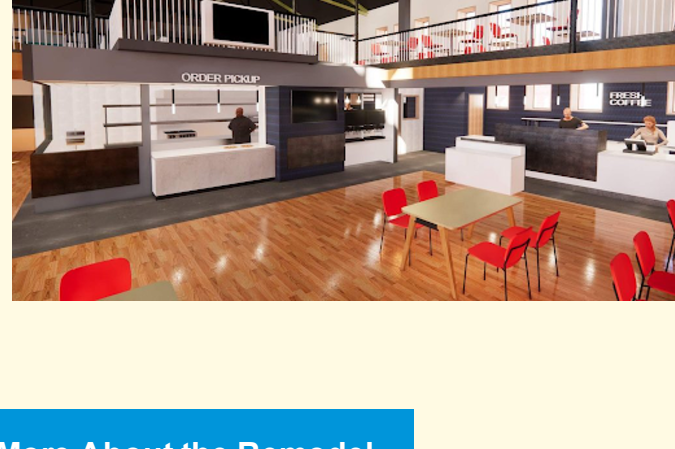


### Carleton Students Attempt Virtual Peacemaking in War College Exercise

60 Carls were recently invited to participate in the United States Army War College International Strategic Crisis Negotiation Exercise (ISCNE). This exercise, led by retired and active-duty military and foreign service officers, among others, uses experiential learning to educate students in crisis negotiation at an international level. The exercise split students into country teams within the framework of a U.N. conference trying to thaw a frozen conflict—in this case, competing claims in the South China Sea. Carleton was the first undergraduate school chosen by the War College; most are held at graduate-level public-policy schools. At the NCAA Track and Field Championships, [Mary Blamford '24](#), [Clara Mayfield '23](#), and [Hannah Preisser '26](#) represented Carleton well. [Mayfield finished fourth in the 5,000-meter run and third in the 10,000-meter run](#), collecting her ninth All-American honors in the process. [Blamford broke her own school record, placing 10th in the 800-meter run](#), while Preisser placed 17th in the 10,000-meter run.



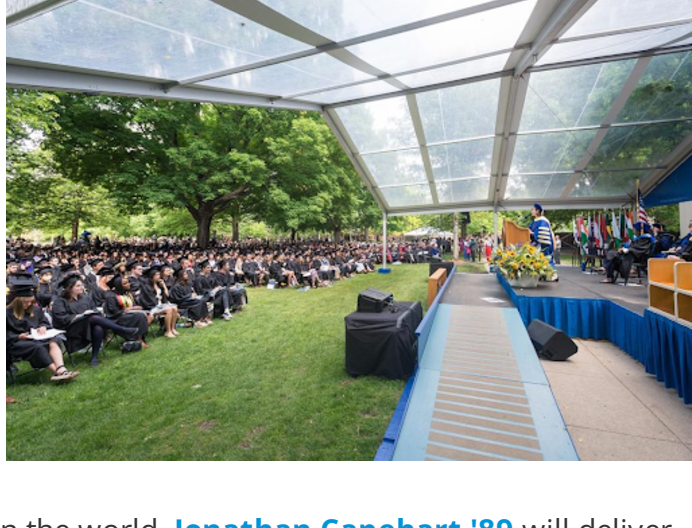
