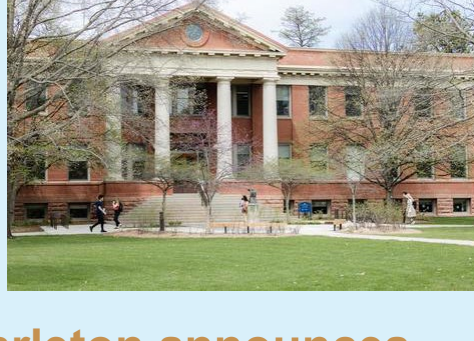
## Here's your news for March from on and off campus.

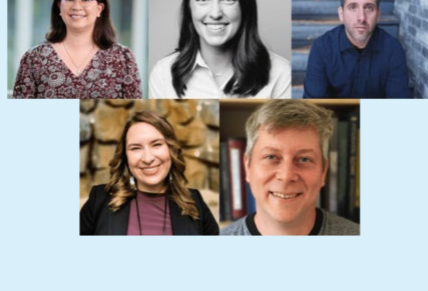
### Leadership in tough times
